

ORDINANCES

To insure that all visitors have a safe and enjoyable experience, please observe the following ordinances:

It is unlawful to:

- Use fireworks.
- Bring pets into Park unless caged or kept on a leash not more than 6 feet long (don't tie leashes to trees).
- Kill, trap, hunt or disturb in any manner any species of wildlife.
- Start a fire in the Park except in the designated grills and fire pits.
- Litter.
- No horseback riding.
- No cutting of live trees for any purpose.

LAKE MARION PARK

McLeod County Regional Park



OVERVIEW

Lake Marion Park is located on the southeast corner of Lake Marion in Collins Township near Brownton. It is served by Highway 15 and is approximately 6 miles south of Hutchinson and 12 west of Glencoe.

This 86 acre park was opened in the spring of 1981. It was purchased in 1975 with Lawson and LCMR Grants. The development of the park was started in 1978 with federal, state and county money.

Before the county purchased the land for a park, it was a mink ranch. In the early 1960's it was one of the largest mink ranches in the United States.
